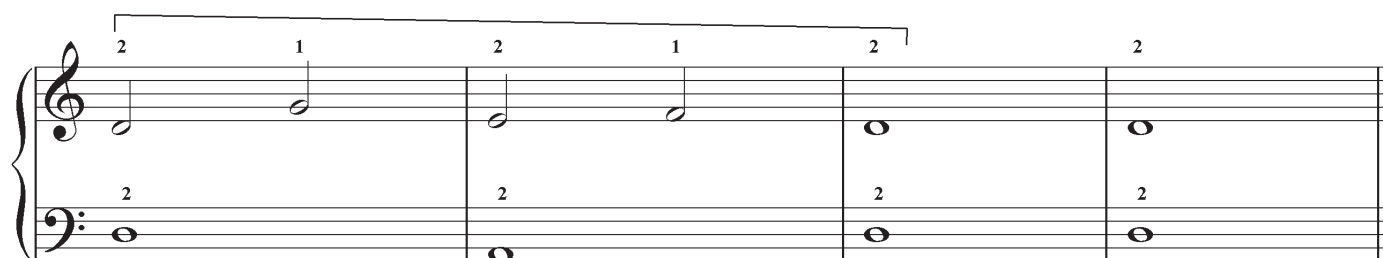
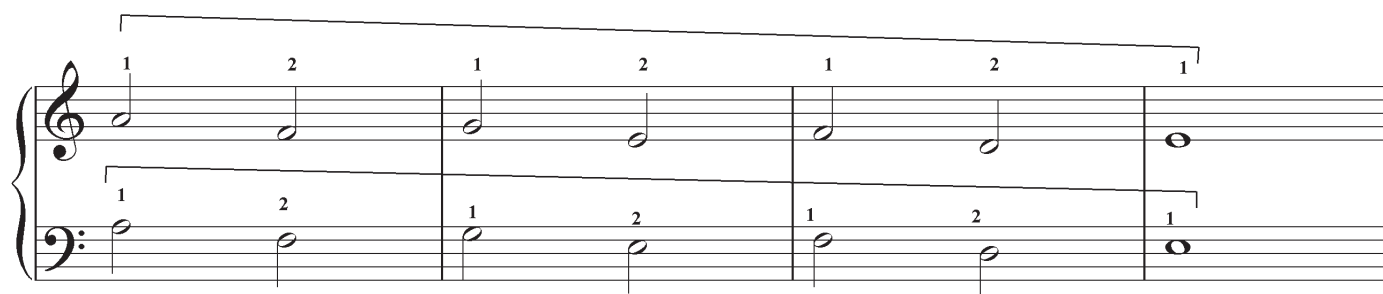
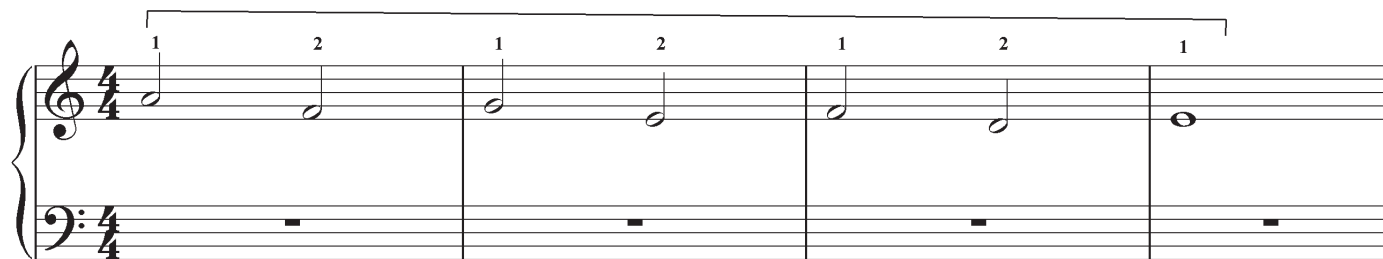


Walking the Trestle

2nd and 3rds in dorian mode

2nds are the intervals from any one string to the next adjacent string. On the staff, 2nds are written from a space to a line, or from a line to a space.

3rds are the interval from one string to the "next-but-one", in other words, a third will be any two strings with one unplayed string between them. On the staff they are written from a space to the next space up or down, or from a line to a line.

The brackets above the notes show that there is always at least one finger on a string, as long as the bracket lasts. Fingers "walk" the strings to produce a legato sound.
